





Fond du Lac County is a well-diversified, leading agricultural county in Wisconsin and ranks as the nation's 26th largest dairy county. Crops are primarily used to feed the county's 51,000 dairy cows. Soil types range from clays to loams and the limestone based, well-drained soils located throughout much of the county are ideal for growing high yields of alfalfa. The area averages about 32 inches of precipitation per year. The agricultural infrastructure in Fond du Lac County is solid. There are competitive markets for every major livestock and crop commodity. Additionally, there are numerous dealers for seeds, feeds, equipment, fertilizers, and most agricultural services (nutritionists, A.I. technicians, crop consultants, farm credit officers, etc.). The local newspapers and radio stations place a priority on agricultural news.
