Join us for the first in a series of trainings in working with children, adults and families who have experienced trauma in their lives. On **October 15, 2012**, we will define child traumatic stress and look at how it differs from PTSD and how it impacts children. The training is about developing an understanding of trauma and providing practical tools for both the professional and lay person to help those who have experienced trauma in their lives.

Our presenter **Chris Foreman, CISW,** has been practicing social work within the field of Children, Youth and Family since 1998. She has spent the bulk of her career working with children who meet the criteria for having Serious Emotional Disturbances (SED). The needs of this specific client population led to her affiliation with the National Child Traumatic Stress Network (NCTSN) and the development of *Trauma Informed Parenting* **(TIPS)** training programs for the Dane County Department of Human Services (DCDHS) in Madison, WI, Community Care Resources (CCR) a treatment foster care agency in Middleton, WI, and the State of Wisconsin.

Chris now regularly trains foster parents and child welfare staff on the nature of complex trauma and its impact on child development. She has done presentations for the Wisconsin State Bar Association, CASA at NCTSN All Network Conferences in New Orleans and Baltimore, and "train the trainer" events in OH and IA. In addition to her child welfare practice and resource parent trainings, she has been an adjunct professor at the UW-Madison School of Social Work offering instruction on complex trauma and the need for evidence based practice.
