Temporary Emergency Food Assistance Program

TEFAP is an emergency food assistance program to area food pantries through ADVOCAP. ADVOCAP is not a site for food distribution to individuals.

Eligibility: participants must meet income guidelines (185% of federal poverty level), have proof of residency and picture ID. To learn more, contact a participating pantry or call (920) 426-0150, x. 3257.

WIC – Women, Infants and Children Nutrition Program

Provides supplemental food, nutrition, and other health referrals to pregnant, breast-feeding and postpartum women and children (under age 5.)

Eligibility: participants must meet income guidelines (185% of the federal poverty level.) Individuals who participate in other assistance programs may automatically be income eligible.
