

Space Exploration opportunities

Advanced Space Academy

Explores college and career preparation through an immersive experience in science, technology, engineering, and math. Trainees undergo a variety of astronaut training exercises, engineering challenges, and teambuilding activities, all culminating in an extended duration simulated space mission. Activities include high/low ropes course, simulators, Russian language lessons, SCUBA diving, fighter jet simulators, advanced rocketry, and more! Youth who participate will earn one credit hour of freshman-level general science from the University of Alabama in Huntsville in this college-accredited program.

Grades: 10th–12th graders as of January 1, 2021
Dates: January 23-29, 2021
Location: US Space and Rocket Center in Huntsville, Alabama
Cost: \$1,550.00 / youth (Deposit of \$775.00 is due by Oct. 1, 2020)
Lodging & Meals: Youth will stay in the Space Camp dormitory, with the exception of the first night lodging at a hotel in route to Space Camp. All meals are included.
Transportation: Airplane & Coach Bus
Registration: June 1–15, 2020 through 4-HOnline. Registration is first come first serve. There are only 32 spots available.


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
