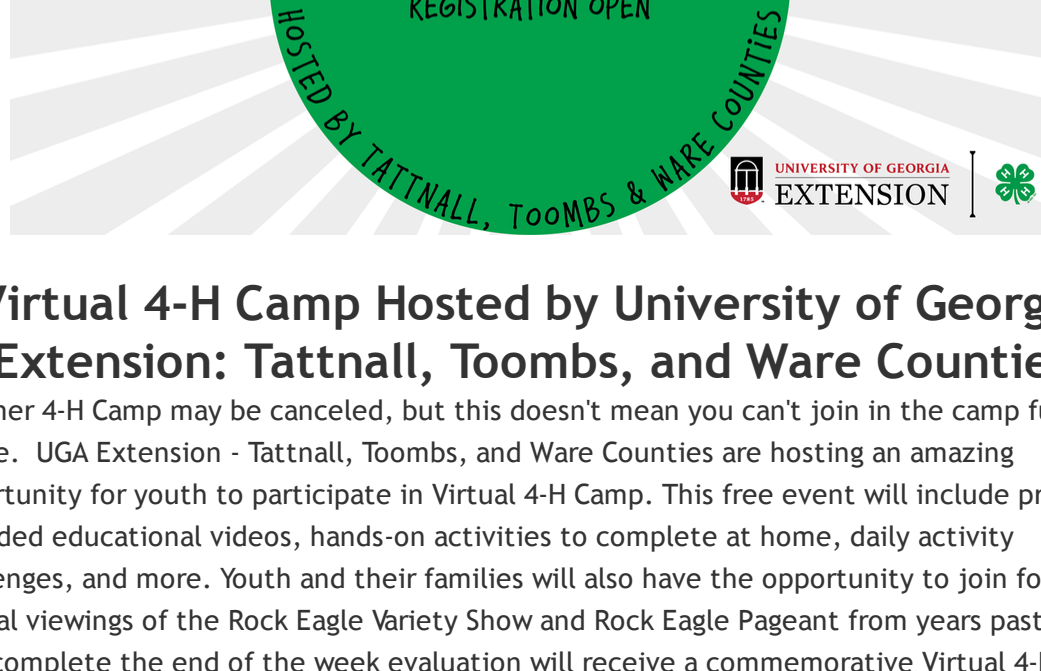


Virtual Learning Community
