WHAT IS STOCKBOX?

Stockbox is a program that provides healthy food every month to improve the diet and nutrition of low-income seniors, 60 and older.

Stockbox provides a monthly supplemental food package for free, which includes:

- Cheese
- Canned fruits
- · Canned vegetables
- Juice
- Cereal
- · Canned and dry milk
- Peanut Butter
- Canned meat
- Canned soup
- · Rice, instant potatoes or pasta



Who is eligible for Stockbox?

You may qualify if:

- · You are age 60 or older.
- You have a household income per month (before tax deductions) that is less or equal to Stockbox income guidelines:
 - Monthly income for 1 person in a household is \$1,632.
 - Monthly income for 2 people in a household is \$2,215.
 - For each additional person in the household, add \$583.
