Dear 4-H Leader.

- Last year we had over 456 youth and 150 adult volunteers; let's see if we can beat that! We are **currently at 512 youth members and 102 volunteers**. There are 52 adults pending their volunteer status due to missing trainings or incomplete background checks.
- \*\*\*Volunteers re-enrolling will need to complete the new training Supporting You, Supporting Youth (approximately 10 mins). If you enrolled 2022-2023 before December 1<sup>st</sup>, you will need to complete Building Safe Spaces (approximately 45 mins). # Family Learning Day - February 24, 2024

4-H members, community youth, and parents are invited to attend. Learn a new skill or gain fresh ideas.

- On occasion, we have received requests for a **certificate of insurance**. This often happens because a 4-H club or group is using someone else's facilities (i.e. school, church), and the facility wants proof there is insurance coverage. Contact Tracy and provide the following information:
  - What is the event
  - The date of the event
  - Location/address of the event
  - The name, address, and e-mail of the person to send the certificate to

We will send this information to the UW-Madison risk manager. They will send the certificate to me. You need to allow plenty of time for this chain to be followed when asking for a certificate. We suggest a **minimum of 3** weeks for process time. Separate certificates are needed for each location of an event.

### Visual Arts Festival

We are seeking youth and adults to be on the Visual Arts Festival committee. Over the past few years this contest has been known as the Tri-County Visual Arts Festival. This year the other two counties are not participating for various reasons. We hope to bring back the Tri-County Visual Arts Festival in 2025.

What that means is we have the chance to do a festival locally. Anyone interested in helping plan this event should contact the office and Tracy will organize a committee meeting. If interested, please contact Tracy by **February 28**! The committee will meet in early March. If there is no committee interest, we will not offer a contest and resume in 2025 with the Tri-County opportunity.
