## 4-H Educator Report

- Family Learning Day had 100 youth participants, 47 sessions, and 40 volunteers
- The first project leader training was held at Family Learning day and had 6 adults attend.

- Approval was received for the 4-H Summer Intern, budgeted for \$5,000. Application is open through 5/15/2025.
- The Foods Revue theme this year is blueberry
- Summer Camp applications are opening soon. There will be multiple offerings with a variety of themes.
- A Wildlife Club will be established in the near future in partnership with the WI DNR
- Seeds for the Cloverbud Pumpkin Contest can be picked up at tonight's general meeting. A Giant Pumpkin Growing Workshop will be held on 5/8/2025 in collaboration with Fond du Lac Festivals.
- New Family Fair Orientation will be held 6/4/2025 and will include a short tour of the fairgrounds. Registration closes 5/30/2025.
