#### 4-H Educator Report

- Summer Camps
  - Art Camp 20 youth (up 6 from last year), 4 of which were community participants
  - Cardboard Camp canceled
  - Cloverbud Day Camp 29 youth (up 17 from previous year)
  - Foodie Camp 16 youth (up 8 from previous year)
  - STEM Camp 11 youth
  - LEGO Camp 10 youth, 4 of which were community participants
- 2025-26 Enrollment
  - Online enrollment opens September 4, 2025
  - o 4-H Online will be shutdown between August 29th to September 4th
  - Current enrollments do not roll over all youth members and adult volunteers will need to re-enroll. Do not set up a new account
- A new project guide will be rolled out this year
  - Hoping to form a project committee that will meet with the 4-H Educator a few times a year to collaborate on events supporting projects that don't currently have much county support. Reach out to Tracy to express interest in joining this committee by September 15, 2025.

- Printed copies of the 2025-26 4-H calendar will be available by request only this year via the Extension Office
- Annual Financial Reviews are due to the Extension Office by September 1, 2025
- Club charter deadline is November 1, 2025
- Extension Office Move
  - The Extension Office will be moving from the FCC to 160 S. Macy St in downtown Fond du Lac. The move will be complete by December 1, 2025
  - Room 205/206 at the FCC should still be available for our use, but a room reservation system isn't currently in place.
  - Family Learning Day will not be held at the FCC. A new location is currently being scouted.
  - Programming is likely to be impacted this fall and early winter due to the move
- Certificates of Insurance
  - UW-Madison's risk management office will no longer provide certificates of insurance for 4-H clubs or groups.
  - o Individual adult volunteers are still covered when acting in their role.
  - The Adult Leaders Association is looking into securing blanket coverage for all
     4-H clubs/groups/events located within Fond du Lac county.
- Send leadership changes, a list of current officers, and monthly minutes to the Extension Office.
- Bylaws and policies need to be reviewed annually and approved by Tracy prior to any changes being voted into effect.

### 2025-26 Budget

- \$44,661.51 budgeted income
- \$39,026.00 budgeted expenses
- \$5,635.51 net ordinary income
- The WI State 4-H Foundation is now managed by UW-Madison
  - Cindy Koffman moved to provide a \$700 donation to the WI State 4-H Foundation contingent on them continuing to fund national 4-H trips for members of Fond du Lac county, Deb Senn seconded
- Deb Senn moved to approve the budget for FY26, Ryan Stommel seconded

## **Committee Updates**

- Silent Auction Cindy Koffman
  - \$3,661 raised
  - Fewer items overall were donated this year
  - Suggested having more people donate baked pies next year these usually go over well
  - Additional help was needed on Sunday night of the fair
- Raffle Judy Bertram
  - Approximately \$4,630 raised, approximately \$153 cost to print tickets
  - Assuming 950 tickets were printed, only 24 remain unsold
  - Suggest getting sponsor for cost of printing raffle tickets in the future

- Fair Food Stands Jennifer Ladwig
  - There were several timeslots where not enough volunteers signed up for each timeslot
  - Received feedback to not offer signing up for specific jobs at the food stand in the future as that deterred some members from signing up
- Achievement Banquet Deb Senn
  - This year's venue is Holy Family Catholic Church on 4th Street in Fond du Lac
    - Reserved for Sunday, October 19th from 10:30am-4:00pm, with event starting at 12:00pm
    - This date does not currently interfere with other club achievement nights
  - Approximate cost to rent facility is \$400
- Trip & Awards
  - o Applications are due September 15, 2025
  - No applications were received yet
