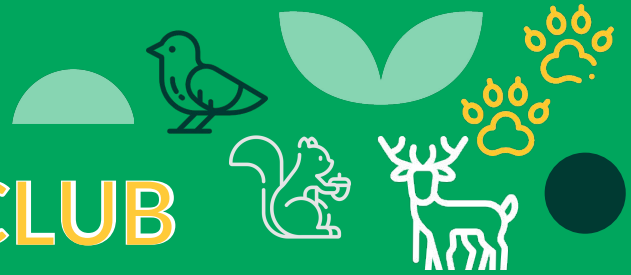




COME JOIN THE 4-H WILDLIFE CLUB

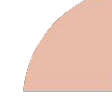
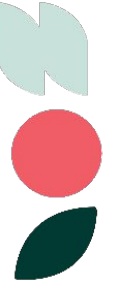

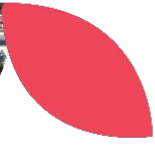


What does a 4-H Wildlife meeting look like?
