Dear 4-H Leader,

Enrollment Deadline - ALL current 4-H members and adult volunteers MUST re-enroll in order to be active in the new year through [4HOnline](#). *Youth wishing to show at the fair must be enrolled in an approved youth organization by February 1st of the fair year. This is a Fond du Lac County Fair Policy.*

Last year, we had over 605 youth and 142 adult volunteers; let's see if we can beat that! We are **currently at 578 youth members and 127 volunteers**. There are still 8 adults pending their volunteer status due to missing trainings or incomplete background checks.
